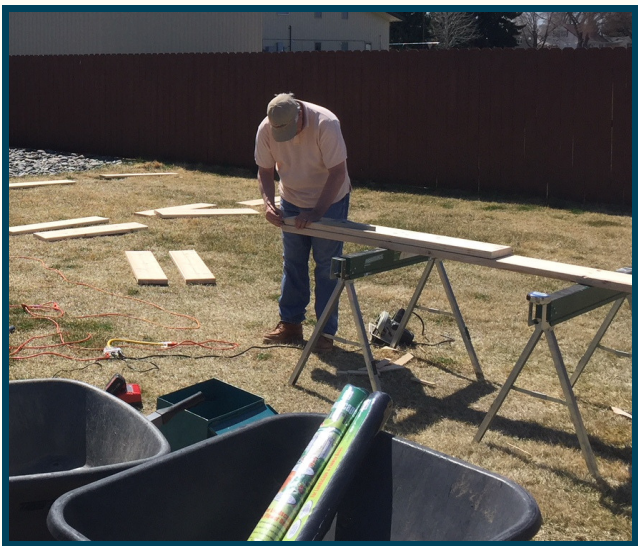


Community Gardens Bloom

HUD Housing Counseling Certification



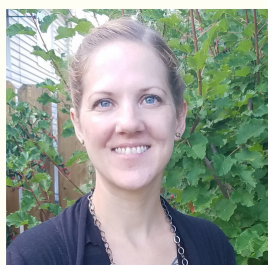
